My 2¢

Don't cry for U.S. entertainment consolidation, Argentina. The truth is, I never left you. All through my wild days, my mad existence, I kept my promise. Don't keep your distance.



Today, U.S. entertainment executives tend to decry the instability and insecurity created by the new wave of consolidation, mergers, and acquisitions. But looking back at the history of the U.S. film and TV industry, the past wasn't all that rosy for the people involved then, either.

Take MGM, for example. The studio went through no fewer than 12 ownership changes in a 40-year span — that's basically one every three years!

Then there's Universal Studios, which went through five ownership changes in just 10 years, or one every two years.

And before Columbia Pictures was acquired by Sony, the studio went through four ownership changes in 20 years, or one every five years.

The late '80s through the '90s saw the largest number of changes with players such as Edgar Bronfman Jr., Marvin Davis, Kirk Kerkorian, Rupert Murdoch, Sumner Redstone, Brian L. Roberts, Steve Ross, and Ted Turner dominating the Hollywood studio business scene.

In a span of just 10 years, games of musical chairs among studio executives were as common as revolving doors at hotels. Between 1980 and 1986, Larry Gershman, who then served as president of MGM/UA Television Group, went through five different immediate superiors. And Blair Westlake, who stepped down as chairman, Universal Television & Networks Group, in 2001, went through 10 bosses over the course of 20 years.

Even at the more "stable" Paramount (which had only three ownership changes since 1948), Bruce Gordon, onetime president of Paramount International Television, had five direct superiors in a 23-year period, and until

1997, he worked under eight different managers, including Michael Eisner, Rich Frank, Frank Mancuso, Martin Davis, and Lucie Salhany.

There was also a whole lot of crime going on, including a number of cases of embezzlement, like the one that involved Columbia Pictures' David Begelman in 1977 (he later committed suicide); the arrest of Giancarlo Parretti related to the acquisition of MGM; and the case of Marc Rich, who co-owned 20th Century Fox before Murdoch, and who became a fugitive from U.S. justice.

And this instability wasn't just confined to studios. Reported Doug Friedman of KUSI-TV, San Diego, California:

"This reminds me of the '80s and '90s when I worked for large U.S. market broadcast stations and syndicators. My tenure at KTLA-TV in Los Angeles began when Gene Autry was the owner. Two years later it was run by an investment company, and later, Tribune. At TeleVentures it was a whirlwind ride with ownership by Columbia Pictures, Sony, and Stephen J. Cannell. Genesis Entertainment was gobbled up by New World, and eventually disbanded after being purchased by Fox. And all this took place in less than three years' time."

Things are a bit different today in that the renewed merger-mania is not affecting much top-level management — people who tend to be at the end of their career curves — but the larger number of younger people who are at the beginning of their careers.

As we all know, consolidation is bad both for the companies' work forces and for the consumers, and it does not necessarily create what Wall Street expects it to. On the other hand, acquisitions and consolidations are facts of business life in the unregulated marketplace that is Hollywood. Plus, as this editorial has demonstrated, they also have historical precedents, which are particular to the business of entertainment.

Consolidation in the hotel business doesn't reduce the number of employees at each hotel. Consolidation of construction companies doesn't cut the number of workers at each site. Consolidation in the farm business doesn't eliminate farmers. These consolidations don't even reduce the corporate staff since larger companies require more elaborate bureaucracies. At most, these consolidations will increase consumer costs and reduce competition.

However, the entertainment business does not have such advantages and privileges, and the underlying message is: "Enter at your own risk."






